## Non-Resident Student Attendance

Students whose parents or legal guardians are not legal residents of the Bruneau-Grand View Joint School District No. 365 may be permitted to attend school programs by the superintendent if:

- The student is a foreign exchange student who has received the approval of the superintendent. A maximum of two (2) foreign students per academic year will be admitted.
- The student's parents have purchased or leased residential property in the district and are requesting advance attendance for the student(s) as part of a move into the district.
- The student has been assigned to residents of the district by a legal public agency.
- The student's parents have moved from the district during the school year and the student has requested to finish the school year under the guardianship of an acceptable adult as evidenced by power of attorney.
- The student's parents are willing to pay state tuition rates and have received the approval of their home district school board.
- The student's parents have assigned power of attorney to qualified adults living in the district.
- The student is on academic track for graduation.
- A check by school authorities to determine discipline/attendance problems.
- At the request of the building principal the student must have legal guardians who live in the district (decision of the principal may be appealed to the superintendent and then to the board of trustees).
