RIMROCK DRIVER'S EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES Registration Information

The six week Idaho Driver Education and Training Program is a formal and organized education and training program to introduce and develop good driving habits and attitudes for a lifetime of responsible, reduced-risk driving strategies. Idaho Digital Learning Academy's <u>online</u> course fulfills the requirement of 30 hours of classroom time. The course will be taken <u>on the student's own time</u>, not within the school day. The Idaho Digital Learning Driver Education course meets national standards for online learning and is approved by the Idaho State Department of Education.

Students will arrange to complete the required in-car observation and in-car driving instruction requirements with a Rimrock Driver Education Instructor. Classroom work and driving instruction MUST be completed concurrently. Students are NOT allowed to be behind the wheel of a car until after Unit One is complete (the end of the 1st week of class). Students must maintain an 80% in each unit to be eligible to drive.

This course is Advanced Opportunities/Fast Forward eligible, which means it will be transcribed on your permanent high school transcript as Pass or Fail.

To enroll in a driver's education course, complete the following steps:

- 1. Student must be at least 14 ½ years old.
- 2. Pay the driving fee of \$150 at the Rimrock office. Students not eligible for Advanced Opportunities/Fast Forward, must pay the additional \$75 IDLA fee. Make checks payable to Rimrock. Credit/Debit card payments are accepted through e~Funds only.
- 3. Both student and parent must visit your local DMV office to purchase a driving permit. The following documents will need to be provided: (contact your local DMV office if you have questions)
 - a. Certified Original Birth Certificates (available from the Bureau of Vital Statistics)
 - b. Acceptable photo identification (student's activity card is accepted)
 - c. Social Security Card or Number for verification
 - d. Proof of Idaho Residency
 - e. Liability Signer (if under 18) must be birth parent or court-ordered guardian
 - f. Verification of School Compliance (VOC) (if under 18) obtained from school
 - g. Acceptable Lawful Presence Documents (if applicable)
- 4. Provide the temporary driver permit stub/receipt to the Rimrock office. Students MUST purchase a permit or enrollment in the course is not possible.
- 5. Create a student account (Follow Step 1 on "Student Accounts" page).

6. Sign and return the Advanced Opportunities/Fast Forward participation form (student & parent signatures required) to Mrs. Meyers.

Students will be registered once payment and driving permit receipt is received. **IDLA does not guarantee course availability.** The sooner you complete the above steps, the sooner you can be registered in an upcoming course. If a course is full, students will be put on a waitlist and will be notified if a spot becomes available. If none becomes available, students will be automatically be registered for the next course. If the registration deadline is missed, students will be registered for the next course.

Students will receive an e-mail with a link for an orientation course. This course MUST be completed BEFORE the state date of the driver's education course or the student will be removed from the class.

The course is pass/fail. To pass, students must have at least an 80% in each of the following areas:

- classroom (held online through Idaho Digital Learning)
- in-car behind the wheel (in-person at Rimrock)
- attitude (both in-class and in-car)

Students cannot drive if the units are not being completed as scheduled. The course will not be extended for students who are not completing their work in the class or the driving hours as scheduled.

This course is Advanced Opportunities/Fast Forward eligible, which means it will be transcribed on the student's permanent high school transcript as Pass or Fail.
